CHECK COMFORT/POSITION

TAKE IN NEW FOOD TRAY, REMOVE OLD FOOD TRAY

ASSESS AND REPORT:

PULSE AND BLOOD PRESSURE SpO₂ WITH FiO₂ DOCUMENTED RESPIRATORY RATE (RHYTHM, EFFORT) TEMPERATURE

AND ASK HOW IS/ARE YOUR:
COUGH AND BREATHLESSNESS
APPETITE
FLUID INTAKE
PAIN

BOWELS AND PASSING URINE

RECORD ALL THE ABOVE OBSERVATIONS (including NEWS chart)

SWITCH TO REMOTE CONSULTATIONS

WHERE POSSIBLE, USE:

PHONES
2-WAY RADIOS
INTERCOMS
