Education services in general are considered one of the largest services that have been affected by the covid 19 pandemic since it was declared a global pandemic in 2020, especially education in the early stages (primary, intermediate, secondary) and accordingly the state of school health care services was affected in terms of accessibility and the flow of services As normal as it was before the outbreak of the pandemic

School health care services affected including pre-school medical examination for first-year students, completion of basic and school-related vaccinations, screening examination programs, health education activities in schools ,This reality also constituted an obstacle to continuing education and acquiring skills for people with special educational conditions and .disabilities, and thus also depriving them of receiving school health care services

It is also monitor the psychological and social effects of students and their parents as a result .of this new style of education, all of which have their health effect.

After the progress of countries in controlling covid 19 with various preventive and curative measures, and with the beginning of the gradual return to daily life activities, and then a complete return to normalcy, challenges also arose for students to return to their schools, including the procedures for safe return, mainly related to the application of basic infection control standards in schools, and vaccinating students with the covid19 vaccine. Starting from the age group 5-11 years, increasing attention to environmental health in schools, obligating schools to strictly monitor the epidemiological situation as part of school health activities. With this return, school health services returned to work normally and completely, taking into account also some of the adjustment that were made to their systems in terms of electronic transformation of systems and the development of new processes within the systems to cope with the requirements of e-learning. Nevertheless, some services still need direct communication, especially those related to medical procedures.

School health care services remain one of the most important health services and one of the important areas of public health as it is related to the physical and mental health of students and thus educational performance and this necessarily relates to the future of societies and
